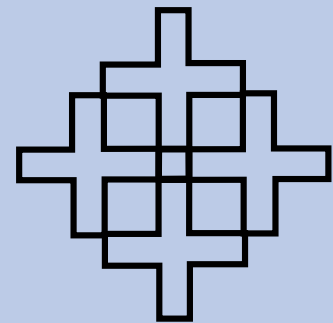

FAMILY EMPOWERMENT SERVICES

Community Connections – A mentoring program that advocates for families/individuals and assists them in creating roadmaps as they travel through Child Protective Services (CPS) and other child welfare systems.

Parent Partnership – A case management program for families who have children with emotional and behavioral challenges and who are at risk for out of home placement.

JUSTICE & PEACE MINISTRY

Promotes collaboration among religious congregations and community groups to challenge systemic causes of poverty, war, and injustice
