FOOD PANTRY

The food pantry is available to all Tioga County residents who are in need of food. One visit per month unless referred by a community agency or school. Surrounding areas of Pennsylvania can only receive a limited amount of food due to restrictions by funding sources. **Food donations are always needed and welcomed!**

CLOTHING & HOUSEHOLD

Clothing and household items are available to anyone in need. All donations of good, clean clothing and household items are greatly appreciated so that we may continue to serve those in need.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is available to Tioga County residents only. These funds are limited. Assistance that may be available includes help with security deposits, emergency prescriptions and utilities to avoid shut off. Financial assistance will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

BUDGET COUNSELING

Budget Counseling is available to anyone interested in stretching their money. The main focus is on spending habits and available resources that help stretch limited monies.

BEDS FOR KIDS PROGRAM

Catholic Charities can assist those in need of a bed with a gently used mattress set. We provide this service in collaboration with the First Church of the Nazarene out of Owego and Beds for Kids out of Binghamton.

JOB BOARD & INTERVIEW CLOSET

Our **Job Board** lists current job openings that are forwarded to us from the Department of Labor. If you need clothes for an interview, our **Interview Closet** has a selection of women's and men's dress clothes.

FOOD STAMP PRE-SCREENINGS

Our Nutrition Outreach & Education Program (NOEP) provides confidential pre-screenings to determine potential Food Stamp eligibility. If it appears you may be eligible, we can assist with the application process at various outreach sites throughout Tioga County. Home visits are also available for elderly or disabled people. WHEELS FOR WORK

Wheels for Work helps low-income families obtain reliable transportation needed to maintain employment. Wheels for Work assists individuals with car loans, vehicle repairs, and insurance. This program is available to Tioga County residents only.

YES MENTORING PROGRAM

The YES Mentoring Program offers tutoring, life skills, and employment skills to youth in the Newark Valley School District. Youth in this program are assisted with skill building based on their individual goals and uniqueness. This program is operated in conjunction with the Newark Valley School District and families in the district.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

When funding and support are available, we are able to offer additional services throughout the year.

Some of the programs that were provided to families in need include: Mobile Food Pantry, Thanksgiving Day Food Baskets, Christmas Packages, Personal Care Items and Flood Relief Services.
